Michael Hill 1.0 out of 5 stars It made a great first impression. I actually bought another printer just like this, wanting to use one in my home office, and another in my wifes craft room. But I wont buy any more of them. The two most irritating problems are 1. Using more than one of the same model on a network is a royal pain. With just one printer serving four PCs and numerous tablets, I could always get the right printer and scanner, even if I sometimes had to reboot a PC to get another one set up for scanning. With two printers, I had to install, then reinstall drivers and software, and I never knew where or even if my PC would connect with one of the printers. Im now using just one printer, and the other is for, well, I guess spare parts. 2. Brother software makes you waste a lot of ink. The printer will stop working if it thinks a cartridge is empty, and there is no override. I have had to throw away cartridges where I can see quite a bit of ink through the clear window. The last straw for me was when my first J475DW printer ran out of yellow ink. I took the almostfull cartridge out of the newer J475DW printer, and inserted it to the older J475DW. Well that didnt work, and the screen said the cartridge was empty. So I put the cartridge back in the newer printer, expecting it to show almost full like it had done just 15 minutes earlier.

At that point, I ordered a Canon printer as a replacement. It has done everything well. Setup for wireless printing was easy even though Ive avoided setting up a home network for infosecurity reasons. I can print from any wireless PC in the house, even though my PC settings do not allow data sharing. Maybe Im a little paranoid about wireless hackers. Ink for this printer is less expensive than for other brands. But the initial ink is still going strong months after I started using the MFCJ475DW. Cost of operation looks like it will be very low. There are only two things I would change if I could 1. The paper tray doesnt hold all that much paper I would guess less than 100 sheets. 2. The Brother software is good, but not quite as good as the software Canon used to provide. So my experience Brother has a much better printer, and slightly poorer software. All in all, though, I think Im a Brother customer to stay. Ink installation is slick, through a front cover. Print quality is nice, noise is low. Scanning seems to be just fine as well. My largest gripe with this printer so far is the difficulty in getting it to work with Linux. While your distribution may handle it better, I had to download the proprietary drivers and manually install them on each laptop in the house. And even so, it wont print duplex for me unless Im using the phone app. Oh, rank that among the positives though. The phone app is very useful, allowing me to print or even scan wirelessly. Overall, Id buy it again. I just wish it had better Linux support. Constant problems with ink. Will not print in black and white if 1 color low. Ink cartridges frequently not recognized, until finally not recognized at all. No power button. Cannot cancel print jobs. Entire unit being trashed after very little use because it wont print due to ink cartridge detection failure. Wifi actually works, and is always available. You can even scan wireless to a laptop or desktop PC!

I have been working with Brother tech support via email and nothing is working so far. Returning the printer via Amazon. I am stuck with two sets of ink cartridges that I bought. Looks like I might have had an issue with those as well as many review mention that aftermarket ink will not work with this machine. The black tends to get clogged, even when I received this item from the seller the black did not work. I had the same problem with my last printer as well. I am not blaming the seller but more with Brother because of that problem but I have been in contact with the seller and he has

been working with me to do what I can do and he is willing to let me send my printer back if all my efforts came to nothing but fails. Brother really needs to fix this problem but this is not an ink problem but a ink head problem. It cannot be contacted wirelessly, and it has no wired controls. Turning it off and on again doesn't help. Resetting the wireless settings sometimes helps, sometimes doesn't. Often I'll come back hours later and my print job will have printed, in the middle of the night. There are no online help pages that give me any assistance, and there's no phone support on this product. The only thing I don't like is constantly changing the ink cartridges. Price is unbelievable and the features, everything you could want in a home machine. This is my 4th Brother unit and I have been happy with all of them. Very reliable machines. This has been a common issue with Brother Inkjet printers for as long as I can remember. Noone, including Brother seems to know exactly why this problem is so common and even why it has continued to plague Brother printers for so many years. In this article I want to first start with the main reasons that could cause this problem to occur followed by the solutions. Overall Brother inkjet printers are very reliable and if used regularly and correctly then very few issues will occur. Brother printers work perfectly well with generic ink cartridges, in fact there should be absolutely no difference whatsoever in both operation and print quality using non genuine cartridges as long as they are good quality generic Brother cartridges. What can cause a Brother printer to not print black. There are quite a few scenarios that can stop your Brother printer from printing in black. Here are some of the main reasons, including a few things to check before getting too carried away with the situation.

Remember that issues will almost always begin when a new cartridge is installed. The breather tape or sometimes referred to as the shipping tape MUST be removed before installing the cartridge. If this is not removed then the ink remains vacuum sealed in the cartridge and it will not come out under any circumstances. 2. Make sure that you install a new cartridge well before it runs dry When your printer starts warning you that the Black cartridge is getting Low and needs to be replaced its OK to keep printing for a while but not for too long. I know that we all want the most from our cartridges but if you print too long and the ink runs very low then you will start introducing air into the print nozzle.

When air starts to get into to the nozzle or the lines going to the nozzle then the printer will stop printing in black. It may not fully stop and you may simply get lines through the printing. This indicates that some of the nozzles are blocked but not all of them. Also when you print with a near empty black cartridge then the air going into the print nozzle will start to dry the ink that is already in the nozzle. If you continue to print like this for a long period of time then you may even permanently damage the printhead. Its kind of like running a car for too long without coolant in the radiator. There have been many articles written about sticking electrical tape over the small window at the front of your Brother cartridges so that you can keep printing and the printer then cant tell if the cartridge is run out of ink. Weve all dont this before but let me tell you it WILL eventually kill the printhead if you keep doing it long enough. 3. Using very low quality generic ink cartridges Brother inkjet printers, like any other printer brand uses specific inks in their printers designed to perform correctly with their own machines. Due to the massive availability of generic cartridges there is a huge difference in quality between one generic ink and another. If the viscosity of the ink is not correct and similar to the Brother inks then various issues can occur. The ink needs to flow at the correct rate and also needs to be formulated to NOT CONGEAL or dry too fast. Printer inks actually contain various chemicals which prevent the ink from drying. This doesnt effect them drying on the actual paper but it does prevent it from drying out in the printer itself. At Ink Hub we have done stringent tests over the years to check the drying rates of various non genuine inks. This has enabled us to provide generic cartridges which we believe are the best on the market. 4.

Weak or faulty Purge Pump One other very common issue that can cause a printer to stop printing in Black or colour is a faulty purge pump or purge seals. The purge pump is the device that you hear whizzing around when you first install a new cartridge. If the purge pump is working correctly then after the initial nozzle clean which is done automatically the printer should be ready to print. You can identify them when the printhead assembly is not docked as they are usually two mesh lined openings surrounded by the actual rubber seals. The smaller one is for the black cartridge only and the larger rectangular shaped section is for the colours. Not all purge pump assemblies look the same however they should be easily identifiable. I recommend that you first visually inspect the purge pump seals to see that they are not buckled or distorted as this will stop the vacuum seal from occurring and significantly lower the amount of vacuum pressure that the pump is able to assert on the ink system. Next I recommend that you give the seals and the pump a clean with either Windex or another suitable, non residual, non oily cleaning fluid. There are several available inc Magic Bullet or even just Isopropyl Alcohol. Take a look at the link above which is quite a good overview of how to clean the purge pump and seals. 7. Faulty Data Cable The data cable is usually a small, flat ribbon cable which connects the printers electronics to the actual printhead itself. Over the years these can also be compromised and cause print issues as data that is being sent to tell the printhead how to operate is either lost or interrupted. Often the data cable can be unplugged to allow the removal of the printhead. Occasionally unplugging them and the reattaching them firmly can fix issues if the data cable is the cause. 8.

Clogged or stuck intake nozzle valve Another issue that can also cause the black or even a colour to not print is that the intake valve situated directly under or behind the cartridge ink outlet becomes clogged with dried ink or simply just jammed. Try removing the ink cartridge and using a cotton bud soaked in Windex gently dab the inlet valve and allow some of the windex to seep into the inlet valve itself. Make sure that none of the cotton from the bud comes off as that would cause even greater issues if it got into the valve. Do this until the inlet valve appears clear and free of ink. Often after doing this the printer may need to be left overnight and often the next day you find that the print quality will return to normal again.

9. Brother printers and CISS Systems Brother printers which have a CISS fitted are also at risk of printhead clogging. This is due to several factors such as poor quality ink being used, tanks not being mixed often enough causing sediment to gather at the bottom of the tanks or not being used often enough. All of these factors can cause the black ink or the colours not to print. By moving the printer to a cooler location it may prevent issues from occurring.

What to do if your Brother printer stops printing black If your printer suddenly stops printing black then check the following in this order.

1. Is the breather tape at the top of the cartridge fully removed
2. Has the new cartridge been recognized correctly by the printer. If not then follow this procedure.
3. Run a maximum of 2 nozzle cleans on the black print nozzle from the LCD menu on the actual printer itself. Follow this procedure to clean the offending nozzles. Note Only use the nozzle cleaning procedure a couple of times as too many times can actually make the problem worse.
4. Try printing a few solid black images with the printer set to the highest quality photo mode. This ensures that ALL nozzles are printing and may help to push the ink out of the nozzle.

If none of the steps above help then you may need to use a printhead cleaning kit to break down the dried ink that is inside of the printhead. You won't believe how common this is, in fact the Error code 46 affects the majority, if not all Brother inkjet printers and there is a fix that you can try yourself to get your trusty printer working again before it takes a swan dive through the window. We're going to teach you what you need to know to fix your Brother printer by changing the settings and without having to replace anything. Here's what you'll learn from this post

What causes Brother Machine Error 46 on my printer. How to reset and clear the Brother Machine Error 46 on your printer What causes Brother Machine Error 46. This is an essential part of the printer and there's a very good reason for having a correctly functioning ink absorber pad, but it's a lot simpler than you might think.

What's more, the error code is often triggered when the ink absorber isn't full, which is why there is a simple way to clear out the error and get your printer up and running again. The ink absorber, also common in Canon printers, is simply a small sponge pad, and its purpose is to collect excess or spilled ink that builds up during printing. The pad also collects any excess ink that might be spilled when a cleaning process is run a printer often cleans itself before or after a print cycle and this uses a large amount of ink. If your ink absorber is full, you will firstly see excess ink on your prints. The absorber can be replaced, but will need to be done by a brother printer technician and will likely cost more than the printer is worth. Ouch! The ink absorber pad can be found in the bottom of the printer and without it, it's likely that your printer would eventually leak ink and stain your desk or carpet in no time without one. Why does my printer think the ink absorber is full if it isn't Once an

ink absorber has been used many times it can become saturated with ink, but because there is no easy way for software to determine how saturated the sponge is, instead it roughly calculates based on the number of cleans and print cycles that the printer has performed and often as a precaution, over estimates and gives the error message before the sponge is full. As the printer effectively counts the number of print and clean cycles, this is done by something called the purge counter. The purge counter can be reset using the menu system on your printer via the LCD panel. How to reset and clear the Brother Machine Error 46 on your printer Firstly before we start, check if your printer is in warranty you will get a 1 year warranty when you buy your printer, if your warranty is still valid then always contact Brother support first of all who should fix your printer for you. Don't attempt the following fix unless your printer is out of warranty.

To fix and clear the Error 46 message, follow these simple instructions. There are 2 different processes for those Brother printers that have a number pad like a phone ones that can Fax, and for those that just have buttons. Hold down either the Menu, Set or Start button you only need to hold one which is normally the menu button, but if you don't have a menu button, then try the Set button, grey or green Start button or the down arrow. Hold this down, then unplug the power cord and plug back in will still holding the button down. It may take some trial and error to find the correct button. Use the down arrow key to scroll through the options until you see Purge followed by a number this is the clean cycle count Enter 2783 and the number next to the word PURGE should set to zero Press stop or exit to get back to the maintenance mode menu. Type 99 to exit and restart the printer. Some more modern keypad printers have a different method to get into maintenance mode thanks to BajaRon for his tips in the comments. Press the blank option at the bottom of the list on the LCD screen. Then scroll through the options until you see the word Purge with a count next to it. Using the OK button again, enter the numbers 2,7,8,3. And the purge counter will set to 00000. Hey Presto! This should reset the purge counter back to zero and stop the Printer Error code 46 from appearing again, at least for a good while. Who knew you could do this Mind well and truly blown! This fix only normally works because in most cases, the message comes before the pad is full, so resetting the counter gives you some more time. Replacing the pad can be very expensive, depending on the printer so you may need a new printer unfortunately unless you've had it less than 12 months, then Brother should replace it for free. Any suggestions for getting into Maintenance mode for my printer.

I followed the instructions by turning off the power and then turning it on again and pressing the green start button at the same time there is no menu button but it doesn't take me to a maintenance window just the same window that says "see troubleshooting in Users Guide" and Ink Absorber Pad Full at the top with an exclamation mark. Eventually the printer will also stop working at all. Unfortunately there isn't anything you can do beyond repair or replacing the printer. Thanks so much Reply Ethan S on November 11, 2019 at 724 pm If you've reset the purge counter and it is still giving you an error, it is likely because the cycle count for the BLK and CLR is also a high number. You can also reset these to enable printing again, but after you do I'd suggest taking a paper towel and ripping it into strips and blotting out the ink absorber until not much ink transfers to the paper towel. The colors are usually just saturating the foam on top, while the black dumps into a lower holding area. You can use a qtip to clear some of the black ink off the "ramp". My MFC440 CN printer seems to do a cleaning cycle very often, can you advise if this can be addressed or does the printer have another problem. If yours is over cleaning it's likely a separate issue that you'd need to speak to Brother about.
